## FAMILIES MOVING FORWARD

---

Donations will be accepted in the baskets in the narthex for Families Moving Forward, a Beacon Interfaith Housing Collaborative program that offers families experiencing homelessness hospitality, emergency shelter and a path to home with support for stability.

Volunteers from more than 40 congregations throughout the Twin Cities metro area create shelter space at their congregation sites. In addition to a safe place to sleep and a warm meal, volunteers share kindness and compassion with families experiencing homelessness. Completing the circle of support, the FMF professional staff work closely with each family to address their unique barriers to stability so they may leave our shelter program for permanent housing.

Families Moving Forward currently has a capacity of eight families at a time. Families are often referred to us by Hennepin County, another service agency or even word of mouth. They are planning to serve Carver and Scott counties beginning in spring 2014.
